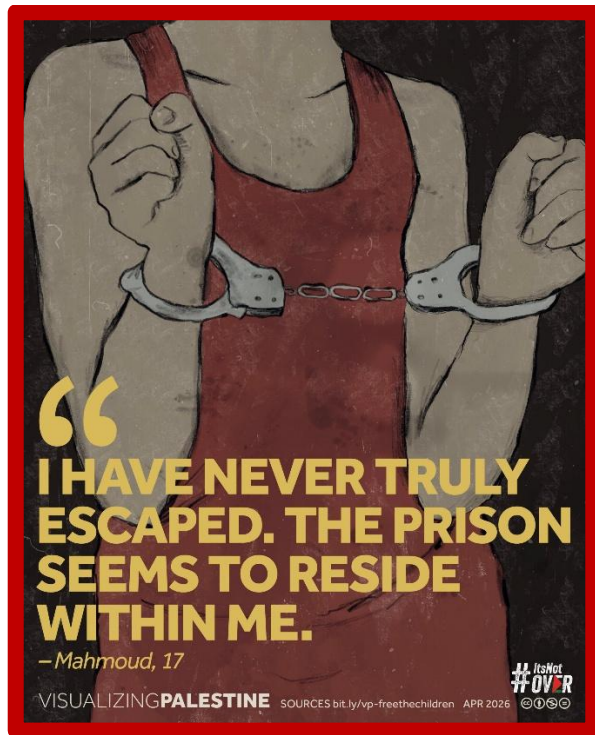


## Israeli prisons: “a network of torture camps”

So says B'Tselem - Israel's own human rights organisation



**Over 9,000 Palestinians are in Israeli jails, thousands of them with no charge or trial.** Children, doctors, journalists, students, young and old – all sectors of society – are held in cruel conditions.

**Torture is common in Israeli prisons** – the guards have even boasted about it on film. No one, man, woman or child, is spared and the maltreatment leaves physical and mental scars.

**Israel's new Execution Law applies only to Palestinians**, who already have no access to fair trials or justice. There will be no appeal against execution. The Execution Law doesn't apply to Jewish Israelis - further evidence that Israel operates an Apartheid regime.

## Join the Red Ribbon Campaign: Free all Palestinian Political Prisoners.

### Things we can all do:

1. **Wear a red ribbon** in solidarity with the global Free Palestinian Political Prisoners Campaign. Tell people what the campaign is about. (Ribbons available on the SPSC stall)
2. **Oppose the Execution Law:** this law will be used as a tool for maintaining and extending Israel's brutal system of oppression against Palestinians.

3. **Sign a petition to free Dr Abu Safiya and dozens of other medics held in detention** - many were taken prisoner while caring for their patients. Five have reportedly died in prison, and others are suffering assaults and beatings. Sign [the petition](#) and pass it on to all your contacts.
