Demand an end to Israel's genocidal war!



Israel's five months of continuous bombardment of Gaza has caused the death of over 30,000 people, a third of them children. And 69,000, mostly civilians, have been injured. The survivors are going hungry and face famine.

On 26th January, the International Court of Justice, on finding plausible South Africa's argument that Israel was carrying out genocide, ordered Israel to take a series of measures to prevent further harm to civilians and to ensure the delivery of basic services. Since the Court's preliminary ruling, Israeli bombing has killed a further 3,600 Palestinians and through its restriction of the delivery of food, water and medicines, tens of thousands are now starving and suffering from infectious diseases. This is not a war against Hamas but against the Palestinian people.

In the West Bank, and particularly in East Jerusalem, where Israel can't claim the pretext that Hamas is a major threat, Israel has stepped up the demolitions of Palestinians homes and, in rural areas, with its army's active support, Israeli settlers have been forcibly evicting Palestinian farmers to seize their land and livestock. While public opinion in Britain overwhelmingly supports an immediate cease fire, both the British government and the Labour party leadership look for all manner of excuses to avoid pressing the US and Israel to bring this about. Instead, they incite against those opposed to Israel's genocidal policy as 'threatening', 'antisemitic' and inspired by 'Islamist extremism'. This week, Sheffield Jews Against Israeli Apartheid, stated: "We reject this Islamophobic view absolutely. It seeks to undermine the strong union between Muslims, Jews, Christians, socialists and all people of conscience who are protesting against the genocide in Gaza".
