Affiliation of Sheffield Hallam UCU Branch to the Sheffield Palestine Coalition Against Israeli Apartheid

This Branch, in reaffirming its longstanding and consistent commitment to freedom and social justice for the Palestinian people, accepts

- that the Israeli state, in its treatment of Palestinians within Israel, within the Occupied Territories and the Gaza Strip, is guilty of the crimes of apartheid and persecution as understood under international law and documented systematically and in detail by four independent human rights organisations (for details and links see Notes below);
- that effective opposition to Israeli apartheid depends on the united action and voices of all supporters and campaigners for human rights and social justice;

and in that context therefore welcomes

the establishment in Sheffield of the Sheffield Palestine Coalition Against
Israeli Apartheid, a project initiated and launched by 4 Sheffield organisations
devoted to Palestinian rights and justice (Sheffield Trade Union Council,
Sheffield Palestine Solidarity Campaign, Kairos Sheffield, Sheffield Labour
Friends of Palestine) in order to create a powerful united voice and platform to
champion the Palestinian cause and expose and oppose Israeli Apartheid
(Full statement of Aims below);

and agrees

- (i) to support the Sheffield Anti-Israeli Apartheid Pledge and
- (ii) to affiliate to the Coalition and send representatives to its future meetings and actions in pursuit of its Aims.

The Aims of the Sheffield Palestine Coalition Against Israeli Apartheid

The Coalition is committed to supporting the Palestinian people's struggle against Israeli apartheid, and the injustice and oppression they experience. It will coordinate the work of organisations in Sheffield committed to this objective and seek the support of citizens, trade unions, businesses, political, community, environmental, faith and student groups.

The Coalition pledges to:

- oppose all forms of racism e.g. racism against Black and minority ethnic groups, antisemitism and Islamophobia
- raise Sheffield citizens' awareness of the Palestinian people's struggle against injustice imposed by Israeli apartheid, settler colonialism and occupation
- make Sheffield into an Israeli Apartheid-Free Zone by campaigning for businesses, local governmental, educational, sporting and cultural institutions to renounce all ties that support the Israeli apartheid system in line with the Palestinian led BDS campaign

- oppose the arms trade and all forms of military collaboration with Israel and call for the end of Israeli occupation and the siege of the Gaza Strip
- call for sanctions against Israel until it abides by all international laws and UN
 resolutions affecting the rights of Palestinians, including the refugees' right of return
- support Palestinian grassroots organizations which promote equality for women, workers' rights and the improvement of conditions for children
- encourage Palestinian cultural activity in Sheffield
- oppose measures aimed at shutting down public criticism of Israel's treatment of the Palestinians
